
Introduction

This document aims to fully guide you through the installation and licensing process for V-Ray for SketchUp and Rhino on Mac and Windows devices (please be aware, there is no V-Ray for Rhino available on Mac devices). The installation will consist of the elements listed below.

1. Creating an account for the Chaos Group website.
2. Generating a license request from the IT Department.
3. Downloading and installing V-Ray for SketchUp and Rhino on Windows Devices.
4. Downloading and installing V-Ray for Sketchup on Mac Devices. (note V-Ray for Rhino is not available on Mac Devices)
5. Configuring the local license server.

Creating a Chaos Group Website Account

1. Go to the following website <https://accounts.chaosgroup.com/>
2. Click the **Create Account** link at the top right-hand corner of the page.



3. Complete the account creation form, please use your **GSA Student email address** and enter a username and password of your choice.

Requesting a License from IT Support

To allow you to use V-Ray you must have a license assigned to your newly created Chaos Group account. These licenses will only be assigned to you by a member of the IT Support Team.

Licenses are assigned for a period of 30 days and you will be given an expiration date by IT. If you are finished using the license prior to the expiration date, please inform IT and we can revoke the license and allocate to another user if needed.

You can request a license by **logging a ticket on the Student IT Service Desk**. The URL is below. **Please detail which license for which package/packages you require i.e Rhino or SketchUp.**

Install V-Ray for SketchUp on a Windows Device

1. Sign in to <https://accounts.chaosgroup.com/>
2. Click the **downloads** link at the top right-hand corner of the page.

3. Click on the link for **V-Ray for SketchUp**.



4. Click on the link for **version 2021**.



5. Now click on the link **Download for Windows x64**.




6. Once the **download has completed, double click the file** to launch the installer package. File name may vary depending on the version number at the time of downloading.




7. Agree to the end user license agreement by clicking **I agree**.




8. On the next screen make sure **SketchUp 2020 is ticked and press Advanced**.







1. Sign in to <https://accounts.chaosgroup.com/>
2. Click the **downloads** link at the top right-hand corner of the page.

3. Click on the link for **V-Ray for Rhino**.



4. Click on the link for **version 6**.



5. Now click on the link **Download for Windows x64**.




6. Once the **download has completed**, **double click the file** to launch the installer package. File name may vary depending on the version number at the time of downloading.






8. On the next screen make sure **Rhinoceros 6 is ticked and press Advanced**.








3. Click on the link for **V-Ray for SketchUp**.




4. Click on the link for **version 2020**.




5. Now click on the link **Download for MacOSx64**.




6. Go to your **Downloads** folder




7. Open the install file for **V-Ray for SketchUp**. Filename may vary depending on the version number at the time of downloading.




8. The DMG file will mount and open a new. **Open the install file.**



9. Click **Open** on the warning dialogue box.




10. **Depending on your macOS version**, you may be asked to **enter your login details for your Mac**, if so please enter the details and press **OK**.




11. Agree to the end user license agreement by clicking **I agree**.




12. On the next screen make sure **SketchUp 2020** is ticked and press **Advanced**.




13. In the advanced section **make sure all boxes are ticked** and press **continue**.




